Royal Three Counties Show is a premier agricultural event, attracting 96,000 people from across the country. Organised by Three Counties Agricultural Society every year in June, and held at the Three Counties Showground in Malvern, this is the focal point for highlighting the land-based industries within the three counties of Gloucestershire, Herefordshire and Worcestershire.

Three Counties Agricultural Society is a charitable organisation that provides educational opportunities within the three counties region that promote agriculture, horticulture and arboriculture. In 2017 we trialled a School Enterprise Initiative, by working with two local schools, who were starting an enterprise at school as part of extra-curricular work associated with their business studies course. After successfully presenting their plans, each school was allocated a marquee to sell their products from during the Royal Three Counties Show.

Terms and Conditions

Open to any secondary school or college that is within the three counties area of Gloucestershire, Herefordshire or Worcestershire.

Applicants may be from a 'Young Enterprise', a general school enterprise, part of a Community Interest Company or similar, provided the product design and management of the enterprise is student led.

Multiple applications can be made by a single school if it has more than one enterprise being developed by students.

Products that are being sold should be appropriate for the visitor demographic of the Royal Three Counties Show ('The Show').

The Three Counties Agricultural Society ('TCAS') will provide an outside sales space, with an open-front 3m x 3m marquee, with a single 13amp power outlet. Additional outlets will be available to purchase. TCAS reserves the right to amend this at any time due to changes in the event planning.

Of the six spaces available, schools from Herefordshire (the 2019 'host' county of the show) will be given priority for three of these if required and the remaining units divided up between Gloucestershire and Worcestershire schools based on merit, as decided by TCAS.

The sales space must be staffed from 9am until 6pm on each of the show days by students, with appropriate adult supervision from the school. The show will take place on the 14-16 June 2019.

The school is responsible for ensuring that the requirements of their individual safeguarding and health and safety policies are met during the show.

The school is responsible for ensuring that all necessary insurances etc. are in place for the show.

TCAS will provide exhibitor wristbands and parking permits for everyone who is working in the sales area for a minimum of 4.5 hours per day. Additional wristbands will be available to purchase at a discounted rate.

TCAS reserves the right to change any of the terms and conditions without notice or explanation to ensure that it can facilitate the running of a smooth and efficient show.
